CONSTITUTION.

—o:—

- 1.—This Society shall be called "THE BLANTYRE PARISH CIRCULATING LIBRARY AND READING ROOM," and shall be open to all parishioners not younger than 16 years of age.
 - 2.—Parishioners under 16 years of age may be admitted to the benefits of the Association, after special application laid before the Management.
 - 3.—The terms of Membership shall be 1/4 per Quarter, 2/8 per Half-Year, 5/- per Year. There shall also be an Entrance Fee of 6d, payable on date of Membership. Members four weeks in arrears shall cease to be Members. Terms for Circulating Library alone—see Library Bye-Laws.
 - 4.—All Members must sign the Membership Roll, and take upon them the obligations thereby imposed.
 - 5.—The affairs of the Society shall be administered by a Committee of Members of whom the Minister of the Parish Church shall always be one — 10 being a quorum. The first ten members shall retire annually at the general meeting of the Society, but shall be qualified for re-election.
 - 6.—The Committee shall have power to appoint Sub-Committees for special details of the Management, and to transfer to such Sub-Committees the powers and functions relative thereto.
 - 7.—A vacancy or vacancies unexpectedly occurring in the Committee shall be supplied by the remaining members.
 - 8.—All decisions of the Committee as to the interpretation of the rules or any other special points shall be held as final except when reversed at the Annual General Meeting of the Society.
 - 9.—The Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be held in January, to elect Members of Committee, to consider any special proposals, and to transact any business competent.
- N.B.—Smoking strictly confined to the Room set apart for the purpose.

BYE - LAWS.

LIBRARY.

- 1.—Terms of Membership for Circulating Library shall be 1/1 per Quarter, 2/1 per Half-Year, 4/- per Year. There shall also be an entrance fee of 6d.
- 2.—Books must be asked for by number, and shall be handed to the Member by the Librarian.
- 3.—Any book lost or destroyed shall be replaced by the Member to whom it was last entrusted.
- 4.—Without special arrangement with the Librarian, no Member shall retain a book longer than 14 days, or have more than one volume in his Possession at a time.
- 5.—A breach of the foregoing rule without satisfactory reason, shall merit a penalty of 6d. no further book being allowed until the fine is paid.
- 6.—No book shall be circulated outside of the Member's household.
- 7.—Books shall be issued and returned on Monday and Friday between the hours of 7 and 9 p.m.

READING ROOM.

- 1.—The Reading Room shall be open on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 6.30 to 10 p.m. and on Saturday from 4 to 10 p.m.
- 2.—Objectionable language of any kind, and all gambling or playing for money in any form, are strictly prohibited in this Room. A breach of this rule shall be subject to a penalty of 1/-; and on refusal of payment shall be reported to the Committee of Management to be dealt with as they see fit.
- 3.—All discussions and all unnecessary noise are forbidden in this Room.
- 4.—Without the permission of the Librarian members shall not remove magazines and newspapers from the Rooms for any purpose whatever.
- 5.—No Member shall have possession of more than one book, magazine, or newspaper, at a time.
- 6.—Games shall be handed out by and returned to the Librarian in charge; and after finishing a game, players shall give place should other members desire to play.
- 7.—Casual visitors, not belonging to the Parish, shall be admitted to the Reading Room at a charge of 1d. per night.
